

## Sparkling Wines

**Prosecco DOC Treviso Brut, Itynera, Veneto, Italy** (11.5% abv) 125ml bottle **£5.10 £22.50**  
A delightful Prosecco: soft textured, clean as a whistle, with green apple fruit, floral notes and a delicate finish.

**Gavi La Meirana, Broglia, Piemonte, Italy** (12.5% abv) **£28.50**  
Pale golden colour, with fresh, fruity aromas of nectarine, melon and citrus. Elegant in the mouth, with fine bubbles, good complexity and a long, crisp finish.

## Champagnes

**Carte d'Or Brut Blanc de Noirs, Testulat, France** (12% abv) bottle **£42.00**  
Rich, fruity champagne with notes of vanilla and peaches. Elegant and well-balanced.

**Brut Imperial, Moët et Chandon, France** (12% abv) **£55.00**  
Beautifully pure, elegant wine, with a refreshing lemony aroma and a delicate mousse. Dry and with plenty of substance.

## White Wines

### House White

**Orvieto Classico, Campogrande, Santa Cristina, Umbria Italy** (12% abv) **£16.40**  
Both floral and fruity notes, particularly pineapple and banana, while the palate is medium-bodied, with more fruit and a round, delicate finish.

**Catarratto / Chardonnay, Angelo, Sicily, Italy** (13.5% abv) **£16.50**  
Crisp, lemony Catarratto balances beautifully with soft, tropical Chardonnay fruit. Fruity and rich in citrus flavours.

**Pinot Grigio, Anterra, Mezzacorona, Trentino, Italy** (12% abv) **£18.50**  
A delicately fruity Pinot Grigio with elegant floral notes, and a refreshing, rounded palate for easy drinking.

**Frascati Superiore, Gotto d'Oro, Lazio, Italy** (12.5% abv) **£18.90**  
Fresh, lively nose with notes of grapes and nuts; delicate, well-balanced palate with a good persistent finish.

**Chardonnay, Castel Firmian, Mezzacorona, Trentino, Italy** (12.5% abv) **£19.50**  
Elegant, fruity nose with hints of red apples, apricot, white melon and citrus fruit. The palate is dry and crisp.

**Gavi DOCG, Ricossa, Piemonte, Italy** (12% abv) **£20.80**  
Great texture and precision, with distinctive greengage and almond notes on the palate. Fresh and dry.

**Regaleali Bianco, Tasca d'Almerita, Sicily, Italy** (12% abv) **£23.50**  
Delicately fruity nose with apple, peach and pink grapefruit notes. The palate is quite intense and crisp, with plenty of fresh fruit flavours.

**Roncaglia Colli Pesaresi, Fattoria Mancini, Marche, Italy** (13% abv) **£27.50**  
Zesty, spicy wine from a grape thought to be related to Albariño; gently floral in the mouth, with melon and hazelnut flavours.

**Pecorino, Fattoria La Valentina, Abruzzi, Italy** (12.5% abv) **£28.50**  
A pure yet lively aroma, with mineral and lime leaf notes, leads to an immediately charming palate that is both delicate and persistent, with great balance between body, freshness and exotic fruit flavours.

**Sauvignon Blanc Collio, Russiz Superiore, Friuli, Italy** (13.5% abv) **£37.80**  
Intriguing aromas of pink grapefruit, green peppers and fresh sage. Crisp citrus flavours, particularly lemon and grapefruit, dominate and linger on the well-structured palate. This is brilliantly distinctive Sauvignon.

## Rosé Wine

**Pinot Grigio Rosé, Mánnara, Veneto, Italy** (12% abv) **£4.80** **£18.50**  
A delicate rosé with lifted aromas of spring flowers and strawberries, red berry fruit on the palate and a soft, round finish.

## Red Wines

### House Red

**Silenzi Rosso, Pala, Sardinia, Italy** (13% abv) **£16.80**  
Intense, persistent aromas dominated by red fruit notes. Well-structured with a soft, plummy palate.

**Montepulciano d'Abruzzo, Ilynera, Abruzzi, Italy** (14% abv) **£17.50**  
A round, juicy red with good earthy cherry and berry character and a clean, fruity finish.

**NéPriCa, Tormaresca, Puglia, Italy** (13.5% abv) **£19.50**  
Red fruits, black cherry and blackcurrant on the nose. On the palate, the spice of the Negroamaro is complemented by the juicy plum jam flavours of Primitivo, resulting in a soft and well-balanced wine.

**Santa Cristina Le Maestrelle, Antinori, Toscana, Italy** (13% abv) **£20.80**  
A full, intense aroma of red fruit and vanilla leads to a fresh, smooth palate with hints of cocoa and a long elegant finish.

**Merlot, Castel Firmian, Mezzacorona, Trentino, Italy** (13% abv) **£21.80**  
Intense fragrance with a mixture of ripe fruits and a hint of oak. Dry, complex and well structured on the palate.

**Teroldego Rotaliano Riserva, Mezzacorona, Trentino, Italy** (13% abv) **£21.90**  
Complex, characteristic fragrance with a pleasant ripe fruit aroma of prunes and blackcurrant. Full-bodied and well-balanced with a soft mouthfeel.

**Valpolicella Classico, Bonacosta, Masi, Veneto, Italy** (12% abv) **£26.50**  
Aromas of violets, roses and mint combined with cherries and spices such as cinnamon and cloves. Well-structured, fresh and full-bodied. **£14.90** 1/2 bottle

**Chianti Classico, Castello Gambero, Toscana, Italy** (14% abv) **£26.90**  
A generous style of Chianti Classico, with ripe cherry and plum fruit, a supple mouthfeel, and a keen balance between juiciness and savour.

**Sangiovese, Fattoria Mancini, Marche, Italy** (13.5% abv) **£29.70**  
Juicy, crunchy, appetizing Sangiovese, with flavours of elderberry and mulberry, and a lovely sweetness mid-palate.

**Primitivo, Torcicoda, Tormaresca, Puglia, Italy** (14% abv) **£32.90**  
Rich, ripe red fruits alongside a light element of prune and some spice from the wood. Soft, round and full-bodied on the palate, with a depth and wild complexity that sets it apart. Voted 61st best wine in the world by Wine Spectator.

## Reserve Selection Wines

**Il Bruciato, Guado al Tasso, Toscana, Italy** (14% abv) **£42.50**  
Fragrant fruity aromas, particularly plum, followed by delicate mint and green tea notes. On the palate it is full-bodied and smooth with a long finish.

**Rosso di Montalcino, Poggio Antico, Toscana, Italy** (13.5% abv) **£45.50**  
The product of younger vines on the famous Poggio Antico estate, this Rosso di Montalcino shares the purity and concentration of Brunello but in an earlier-drinking, more accessible form. Thrilling strawberry and cherry fruit mingles with smoke and spice in this elegant, classic wine.

**Barolo, Prunotto, Piemonte, Italy** (14% abv) **£56.50**  
Complex nose with notes of violet and forest fruits. Floral, smoky and intensely elegant on the palate, this is Barolo at its best.

**Costasera Amarone della Valpolicella Classico, Masi, Veneto, Italy** (15% abv) **£65.00**  
Intense aromas of preserved cherries and dried plums together with hints of fruits of the forest and cinnamon. Good weight from the alcohol and structured on the palate, opening out to attractive aromas of cherries and vanilla. Long, velvety finish.
